The sole purpose of the CACW Royce Martin, Jr. Annual Scholarship is to help plant seeds of success in our younger generation by cultivating and inspiring our youth to pursue higher education or develop a lifelong trade. This year, scholarships will be awarded to recipients in the Warren County and Bowling Green, KY area. It is important to us that we leave positive footprints in these communities that have served as hosts to the annual Cultural Awareness Corvette Weekend for the past 4 years.

Scholarship awards will be a **minimum of \$500** and presented during the Cultural Awareness Corvette Weekend Inc. Ring of Honor Banquet held in August. Recipients will be recognized in front of Corvette clubs and enthusiasts from across the United States. We look forward to the opportunity to support and empower our youth as they make strides into the future.

Scholarship Criteria

Applicant must be a graduating high school senior with a **minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA** for high school and show proof of enrollment as a full-time student for the Fall semester at a community college, university, or trade school.

Disbursement

- Scholarship recipients will be notified by letter from the President of the CACW.
- Scholarships will be awarded annually, subject to available funds.
 - Scholarship awards will be made in August during the CACW Ring of Honor Banquet.
 - The scholarship award will be deposited with the university, college or institution of higher learning to which the student is accepted, admitted, and will attend.
 - The award money is credited to an account in the individual's name to be drawn upon for the following:
 - (1) Fees or charges required for tuition.
 - (2) Fees or charges for room and board while attending school.
 - (3) Expenses for textbooks, course work, lab fees and other materials as required by a course instructor.
- Scholarship awards are not transferable to another individual or institution and are forfeited by the recipient upon withdrawal from the institution where the scholarship award was disbursed by the CACW.

- The applicant is responsible for ensuring the application and all supporting documentation are received by the deadline. Materials must be emailed to RoyceMartinJrScholarshipfund@yahoo.com
- An official copy of your high school transcript report must be included with the application and should list all grade points earned and academic course work completed to date.

Applicants must have a minimum 2.75 GPA

- A 200-word essay, typed, explaining how the applicant would benefit from the scholarship.
- The applicant must provide at least **two (2) letters of recommendation (must be typed)**.
 - (a) One letter of recommendation must be from a teacher, school administrator, counselor or work supervisor, who can address the qualification and/or academic aptitude of the scholarship applicant.
 - (b) Other recommendations can be from a member of your local community, such as a coach, activity instructor, mentor, or Sunday school teacher, etc....
 - (c) The required letters of recommendation **may not** be from any immediate family members, close family friends, or blood relatives.
